## **Courtside Notes:**

Tips on playing **WINNING DOUBLES** while having fun! For our GH league teams compliments of Hobson Performance Tennis

- •Poach, & poach often! Stop waiting for the ball to come to you (as you're at the net). Your partner needs you to be active even if you don't get to the ball. If you are active at the net, you will prove to be a distraction to your opponents which is what you want!
- •Do not be discouraged if you get passed once in a while, shake it off & continue being active at the net!
- •Do not worry about disappointing your doubles partner! Often players tend to play safe in their attempt to not disappoint their partners. It is crucial that you develop a healthy relationship with your tennis mate in the sense that you complement each other when things go well and encourage, show respect when mistakes happen!
- •Above all, try to just be yourself: Play the way it feels right for you and show the same appreciation for your partner's play too!
- •Think placement more than power in doubles. Avoid shoulder high strokes to your opponents because those are easy to volley and put away.
- •The serve is very important: Go for placement (close to the center line) and vary it so as not to be too predictable.
- •You and your partner should choose your 'victim' early in the game! Analyze together who is the weaker player among the opposing two players and focus your strategy around that opponent
- •If your partner has a bad start, do not scold him/her and never show that you are frustrated with his/her performance. Instead, understand that he/she is doing their best and encourage him/her at all times! The momentum does change in favor of those who stay positive and believe in it!
- •Lastly, laugh! Play for fun & exercise! Be somebody people enjoy having on the court next to them or against them. Life is too short to take ourselves seriously! Play tennis for the right reasons only....
