The following is an excerpt of a letter.....

From the Superintendents desk:

Over the next two months, construction will begin on two of the greens complexes. The bunker in front of the green on hole # 5 will be removed in order for the size of the green to almost be doubled. The current putting surface will be re-contoured and will include a new front level where the old bunker was located. Your approach to the green on hole # 14 will see an entirely different look. A new complex will be constructed to the left of where the current green is now. This complex will bring the stream that crosses the fairway into play and more importantly, it will allow full sunlight on the green for 7 to 10 hours a day. The distance of the hole may change some but by only 10 yards, at the most.
